St. Paul says in his second letter to the Corinthians: "We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed but not in despair." (2 Cor 4:8)

We at the Awareness Foundation have been under enormous pressure after the spread of COVID-19 and then the lockdown because we were unable to carry out face-to-face engagements or running any events. The Foundation lost more than a hundred thousand pounds due to the cancellation of two major fundraising events. The first one was a dinner which would have been very kindly hosted by our Royal Patron HRH The Countess of Wessex at Buckingham Palace, and the other one was our Annual Gala Dinner. Fundraising is even more vitally important for the survival of the Awareness Foundation and we are extremely grateful to all our friends and supporters for their continued care. Our Boards of Trustees and Directors in the UK, USA and Canada have been a fantastic pillar of strength for us in this difficult time and we are deeply grateful to them. Having said that, we are hugely blessed to see the impact that we have made on so many people during the pandemic. We are indeed not crushed or in despair.

The Impact of COVID-19 on Awareness

The pandemic affected the work of the Awareness Foundation dramatically because we have not been able to go to the Middle East to run our programmes there. However, we continued our programmes online and developed new programmes:

1. Awareness Live

Our first online Facebook-based programme called Awareness Live aimed at Arabic-speaking youth. Awareness Live runs for 18 consecutive weeks, we had very high-quality speakers including bishops, scientists, educators, priests and civic leaders. Our speakers chose extremely interesting and relevant topics to talk about, including Artificial Intelligence, The Importance of Unity and Diversity in the Society, Bullying, Christianity and Sectarianism, and more. We were delighted to see that thousands of Arabic-speaking young people from all over the world were following it and watching the videos. We have been really blessed with the high level of engagement from so many young adults in the Middle East and beyond.



We are planning to start Season Two of Awareness Live at the beginning of Advent for 5 weeks.



2- Awareness Dialogue



During the lockdown caused by the pandemic, we developed a new programme called 'Awareness Dialogue'. As its title suggests, this is a conversation with religious and lay leaders in different fields. The programme is recorded, edited and released on social media including YouTube and Facebook. We were delighted to release the first video of Awareness Dialogue, which featured our Royal Patron HRH The Countess of Wessex GCVO.





We had also the pleasure to release a conversation with a Maronite priest (Catholic) who spoke about the horrible explosion in Beirut this August. Our guests include artists, journalists, psychologists, clergy and economists.

3. Ambassadors for Peace in Action

The lockdown period was difficult for our young people in the Near East because it put them under extra pressure after years of living in a warzone. We tried our best to engage with them and keep them focused and busy. We asked them to use their mobile phones to record messages of ideas that young people can do during the lockdown. The first video featured ideas on how to stay active during the lockdown, and the second video was about how they implemented those ideas and their feedback.

The results were amazing and we were able to collect many short video clips which were edited into two videos that we released on

We also received many deeply moving videos messages in English and Arabic of support from our friends in the Middle East, EU, Uk, US, Canada and Hong Kong.

PAX and New Releases

Since the beginning of the Pandemic, we have released three new PAX videos. The first one was about the virus and whether it is a punishment from God, the second one was about COVID-19 and Easter, and the third was a video made out of different audiovisual contributions from lay and religious leaders in the New East reflecting on their vision of life after COVID-19. All of those videos have subtitles in English and Arabic.
